Reward Details:

- Amount: \$2,500 USD
- Frequency: The Young Planet Leader of the Year Scholarship is awarded once per year.
- The award will be disbursed directly to the winner, their organization, or their legal guardians to be used exclusively for the purpose outlined in their application.

Submission Deadline: The deadline for this scholarship application will be December 20th, 2024. A single awardee will be chosen by January 1st, 2025.

Entries will be evaluated by our contest board based on the applicant's commitment to environmental sustainability or another meaningful cause, the potential impact of their project or initiatives, the clarity of their vision as it relates to use of awarded funds, and their demonstrated leadership and accomplishments in the field.

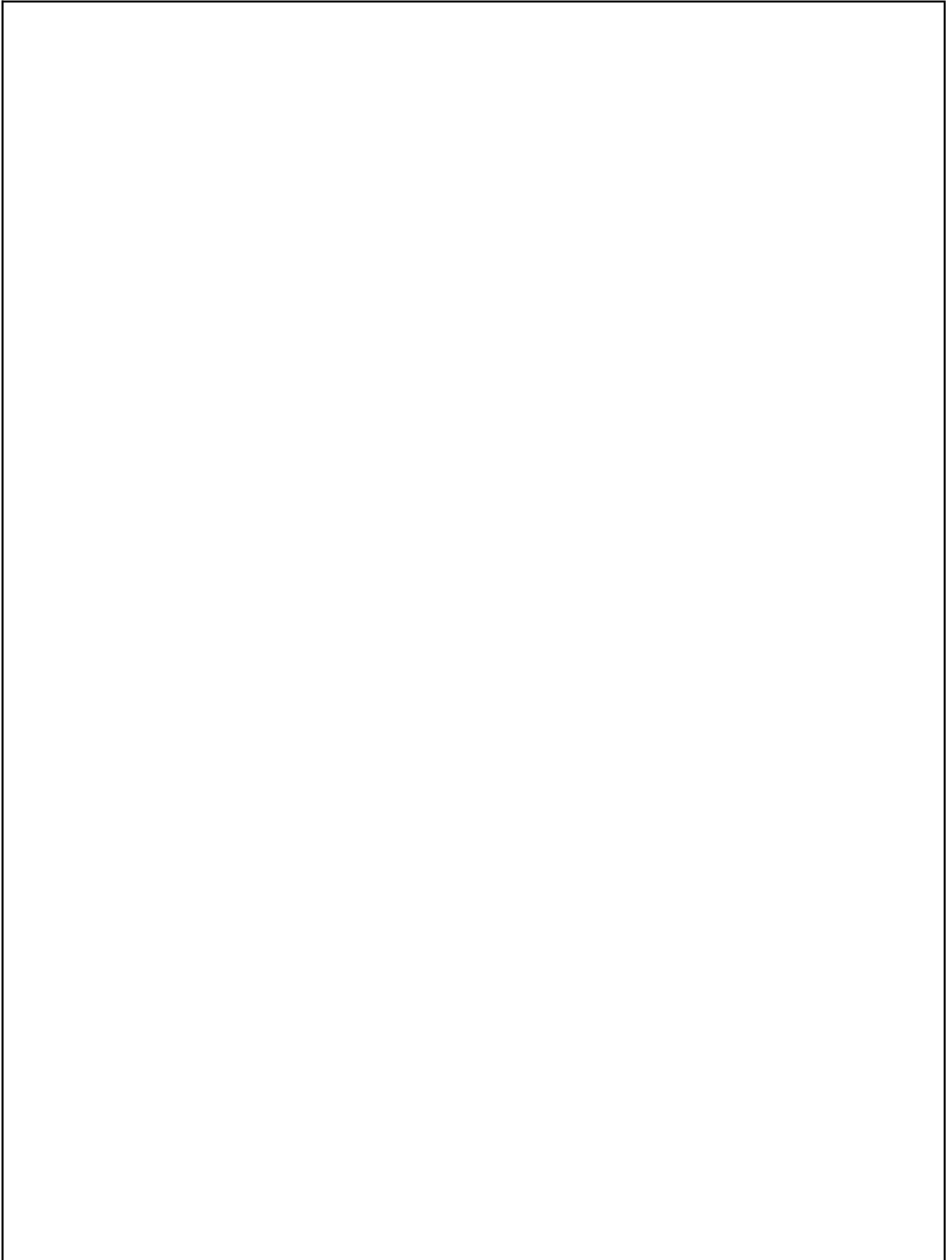

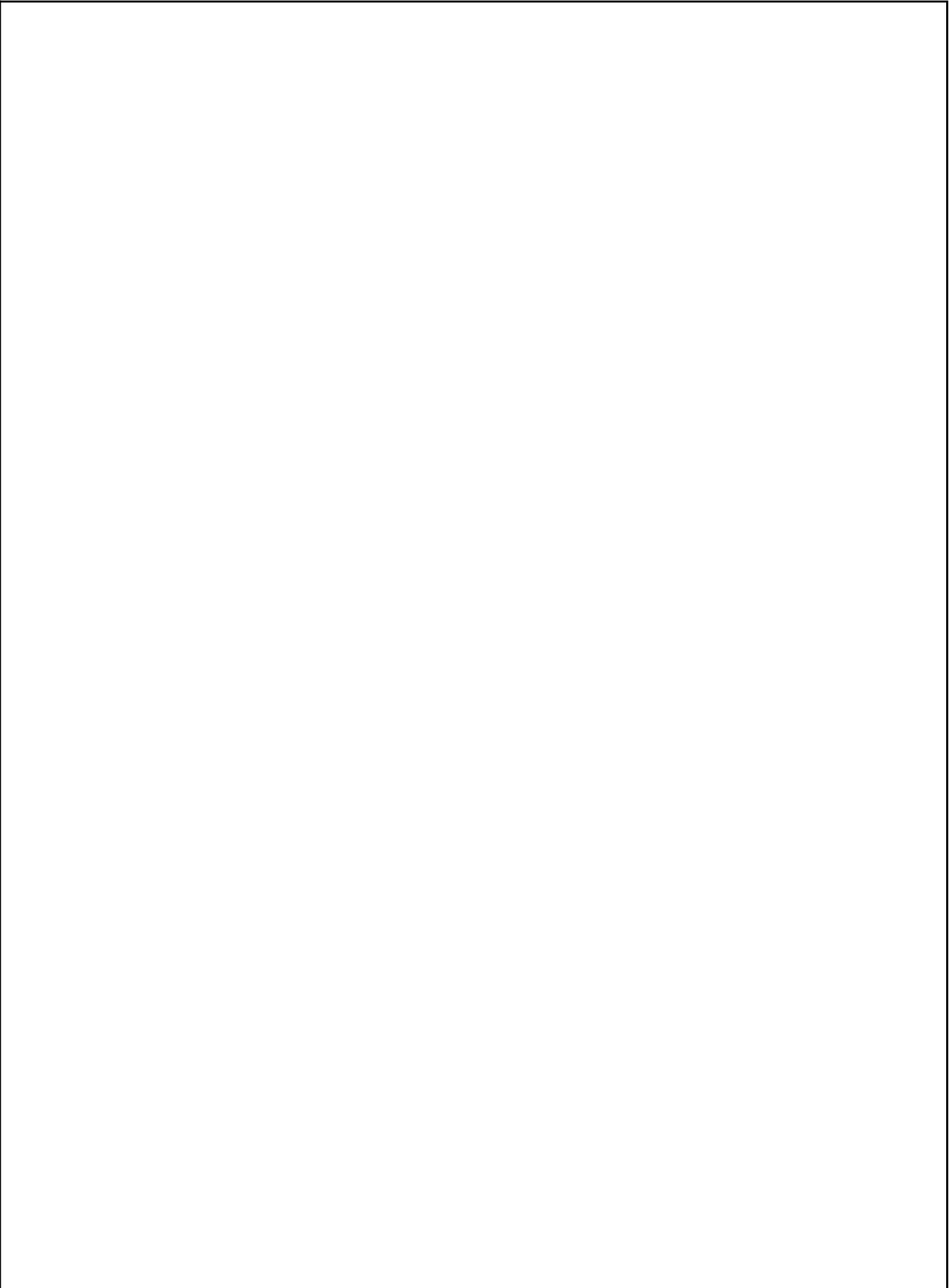
